Re: Comic Relief - Non Uniform Day

I am writing to inform you that Monday 16th March 2015 will be a non uniform day. Non uniform days are one of the ways in which we can raise money for a chosen charity. If your child wishes to take part they are asked to donate £1 to Comic Relief. Envelopes will be provided in the Heart Space at the beginning of the school day for students to make their donation.

All monies raised will go towards Comic Relief to help support children who do not have the opportunity of being able to attend school.
